UNICEF is present in 190 countries and territories to protect the rights of every child. It operates on five continents, supporting governments to reduce and ultimately eliminate mortality and morbidity associated with vaccine-preventable diseases, and give all children a fair chance to reach their full potential in health and well-being. To maximize results, UNICEF Supply Division partners with or acts as procurement agency for a number of initiatives, including, but not limited to Gavi, the Vaccine Alliance, the Gates Foundation, the Measles and Rubella Initiative, and the Global Polio Eradication Initiative. UNICEF Supply Division has a key role in procurement of vaccines and immunization supplies on behalf of around 100 countries annually, supplying over 2 billion doses of vaccines reaching close to half the world's children in support of routine immunization programmes, preventive campaigns, outbreak and emergency response activities.

The 2025 Vaccine Industry Consultation will take place over three days in Copenhagen, covering key vaccine markets including Penta/Hexavalent, Pneumococcal, Rotavirus, Human Papillomavirus, Measles-containing, Yellow Fever, Meningitis, and Polio in addition to new and emerging vaccines. The various sessions will include updates on the immunization landscape in 2025, marked by changes in the global geopolitical context and a constrained resource environment, as well as updates from the WHO pre-qualification team. We will also explore key topics such as local manufacturing of vaccines, sustainability, and logistics.

We look forward to welcoming vaccine industry representatives and global partners in immunization in Copenhagen!
