





- 15.8M beneficiaries reached in 2023, including 10M children and 3.5M women;
- Of the reached, 5.6M people had been affected by the earthquakes, this includes 3.2M children.
- 4.5M people reached in most severly affected and moderate to access areas.
- 3.1M Internally Displaced People "IDPs" reached across the country, which represents 44% of the total estimated IDPs.
