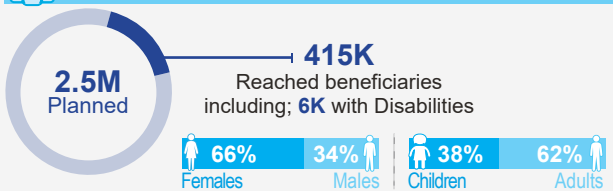

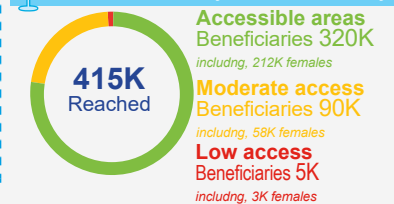

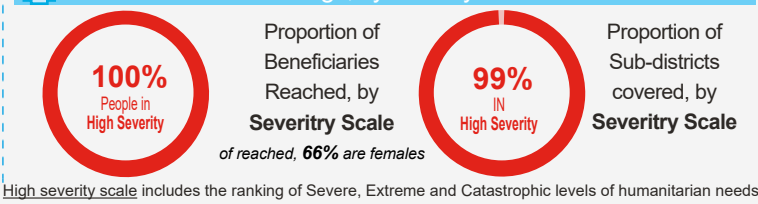
Beneficiaries versus Planned Target



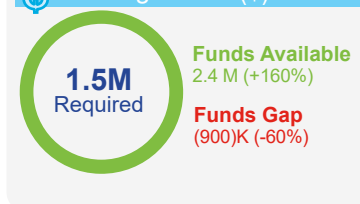
Beneficiaries, by Access Quality



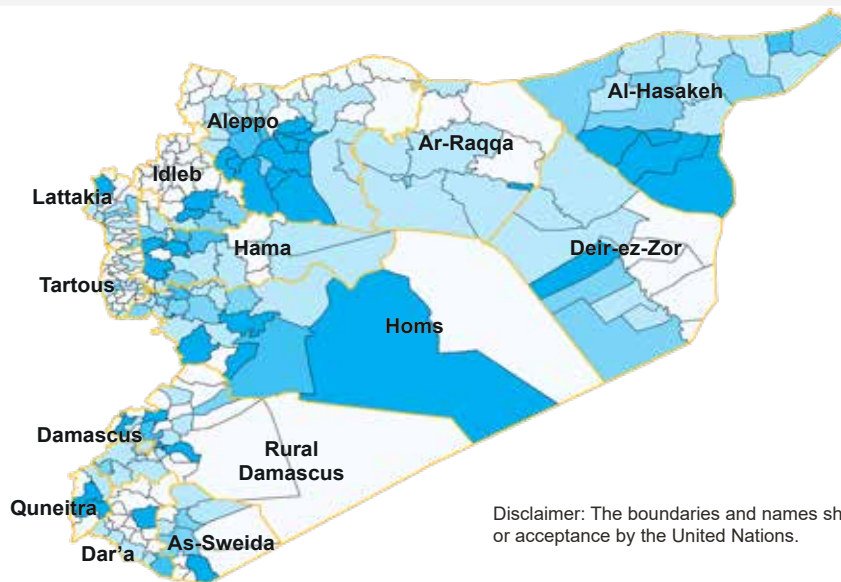
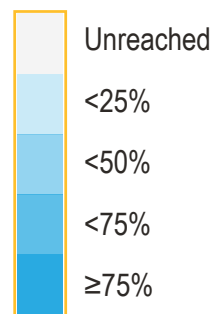
SBC Reach and Coverage, by Severity Scale

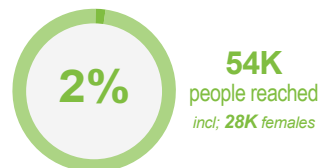

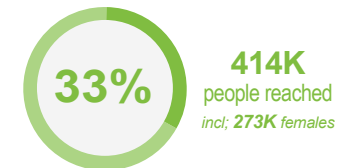
