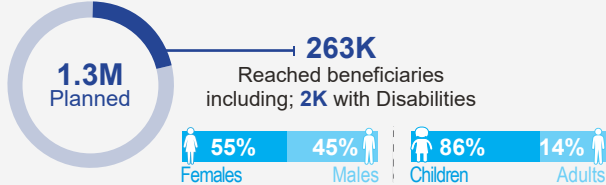

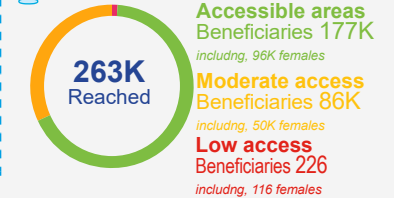

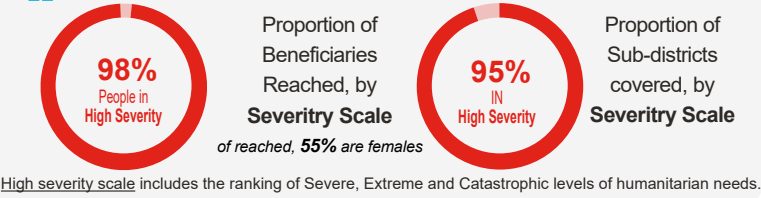
Beneficiaries versus Planned Target



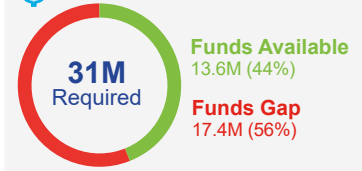
Beneficiaries, by Access Quality



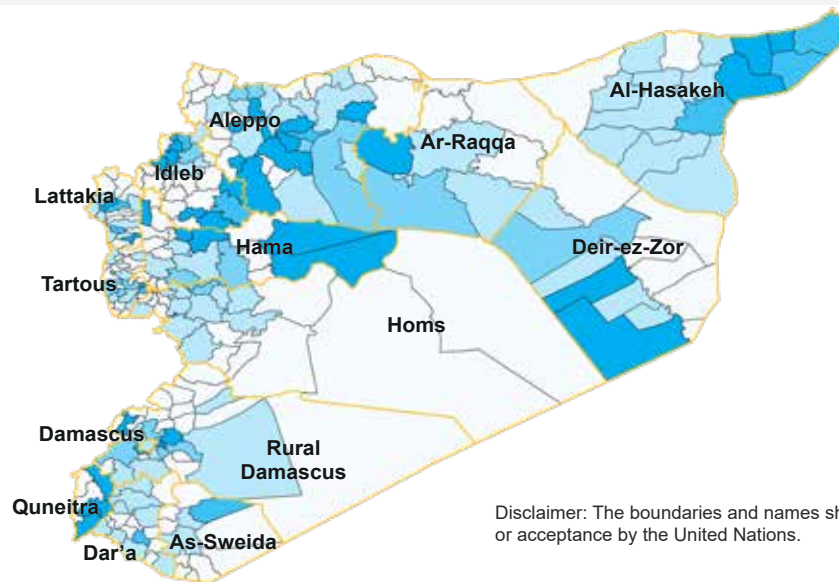
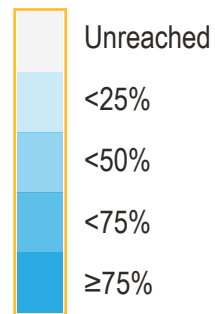
Child Protection Reach and Coverage, by Severity Scale

- 591 Locations reached; out of 8,100

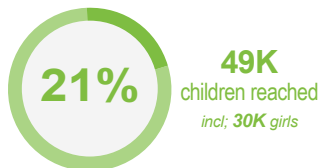

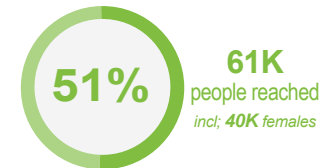

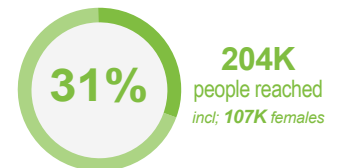
