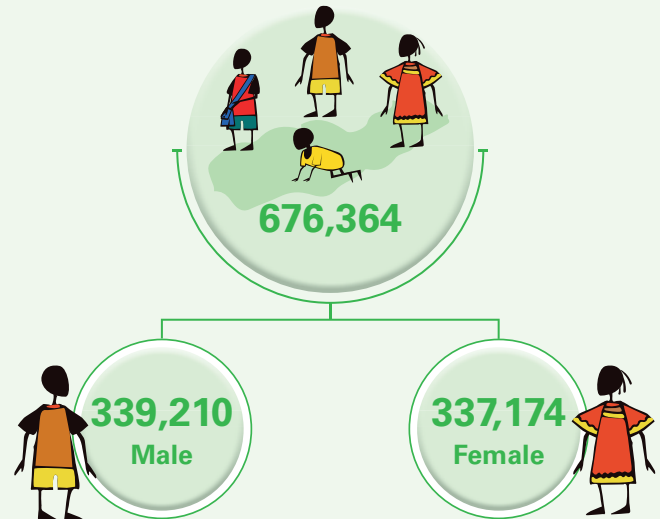

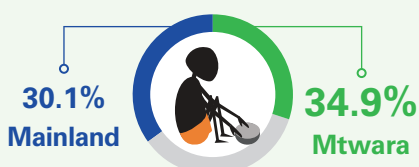
Proportion of Mainland Tanzania children (0-17)¹

Population growth rate for Mtwaru^{1,2}

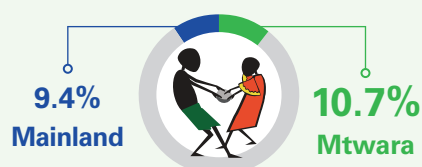

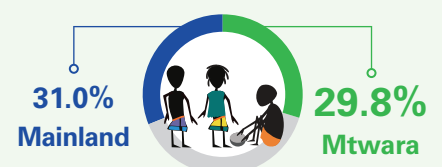
Children experiencing basic needs poverty³



Children experiencing food (or extreme) poverty³

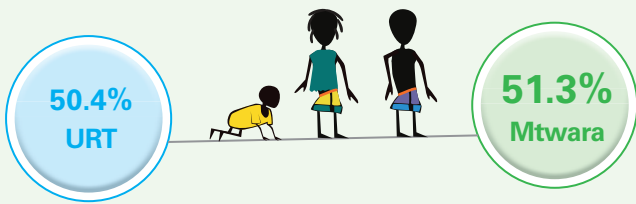


Children experiencing multidimensional poverty - deprived in three or more dimensions⁴

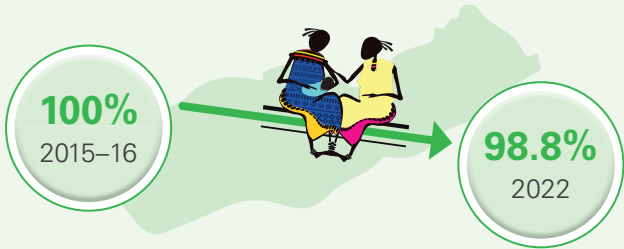
Under-five mortality⁶



Percentage of women receiving four or more ante-natal care (ANC) visits⁷



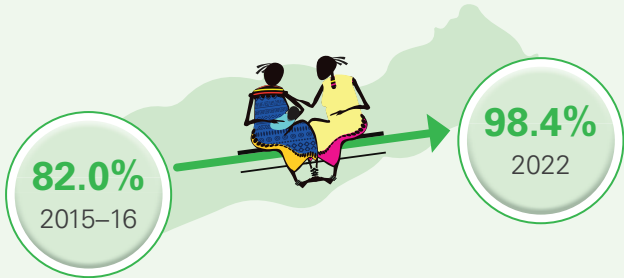
Percentage of women receiving ANC services from a skilled provider^{5,7}



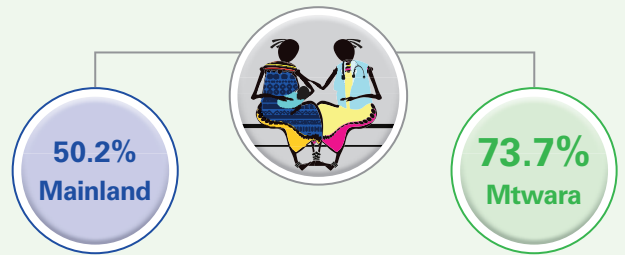
Percentage delivered by a health facility (Institutional delivery)^{5,7}



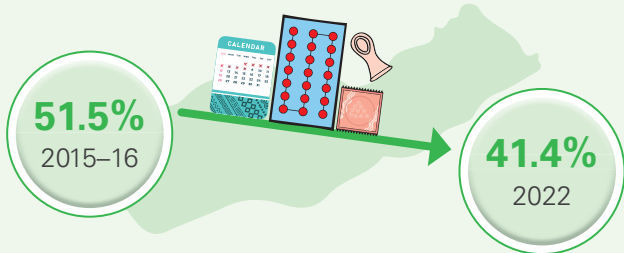

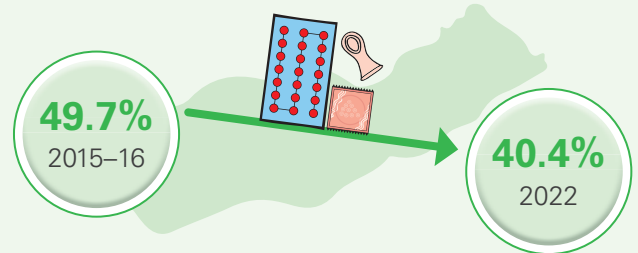
Percentage of women with a postnatal check during the first two days after birth⁷



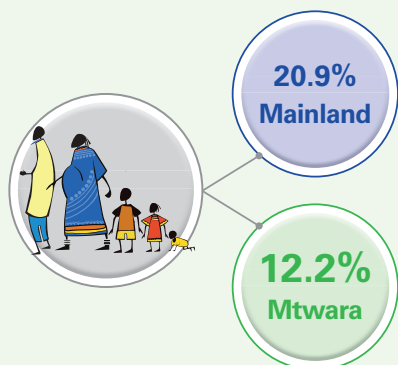
Women using any method of contraception (modern or traditional)^{5,7}



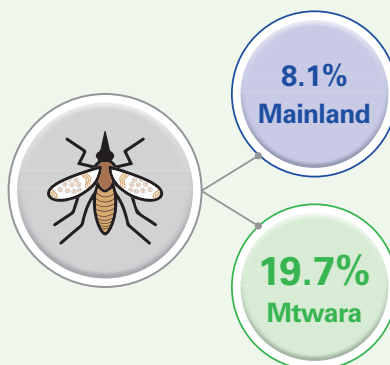

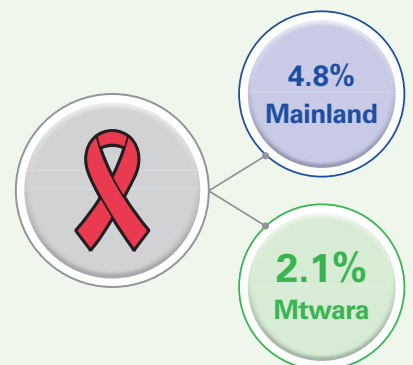
Unmet need for family planning⁷



Prevalence of malaria in children under 5⁷

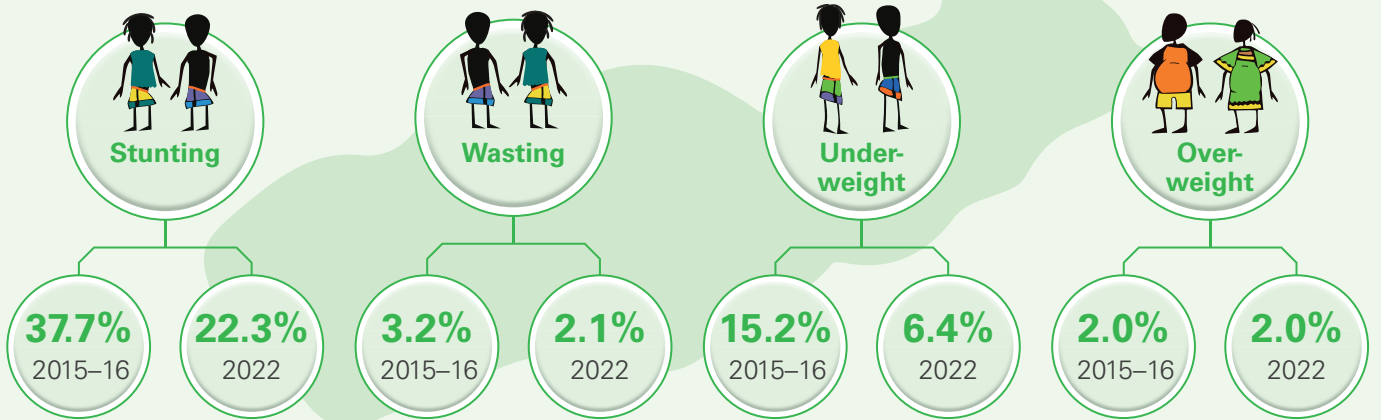


Prevalence of HIV among persons aged 15-49 years⁸

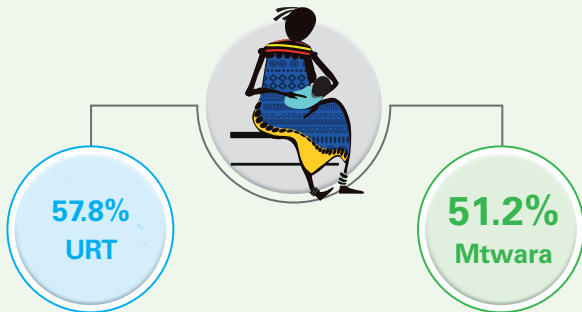

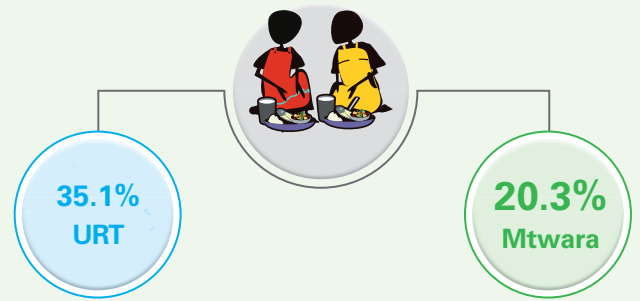
Nutritional status among children under 5^{5,7}



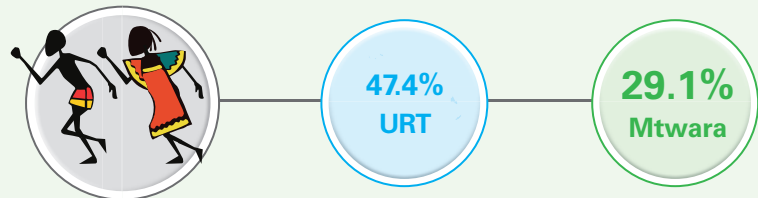
Exclusive breastfeeding⁹



Children 6-23 months receiving minimum dietary diversity (4 or more food groups)⁹

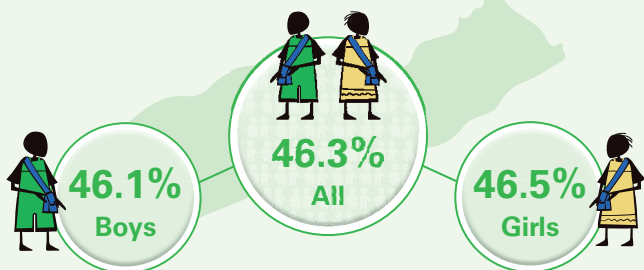


Children age 24-59 months who are developmentally on-track in health, learning and psychological well-being⁷

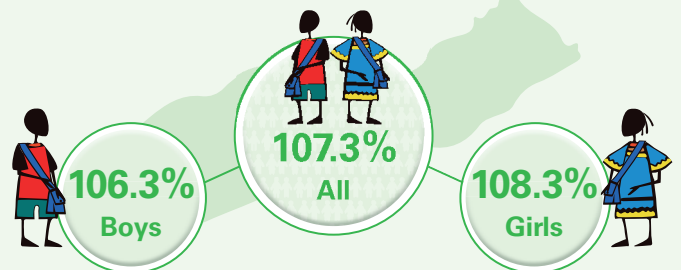

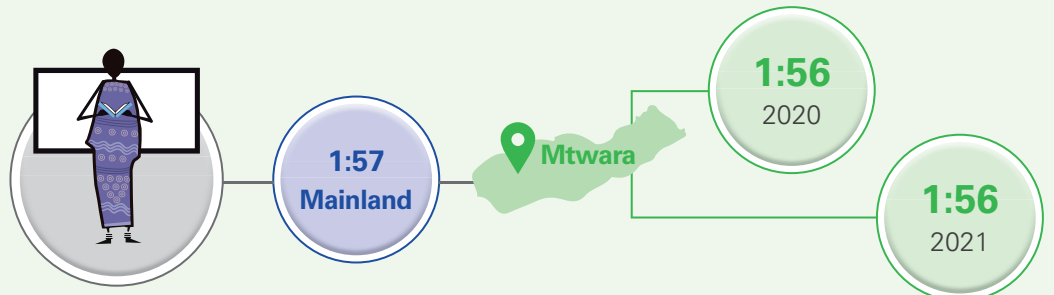
Pre-primary school NER¹⁰

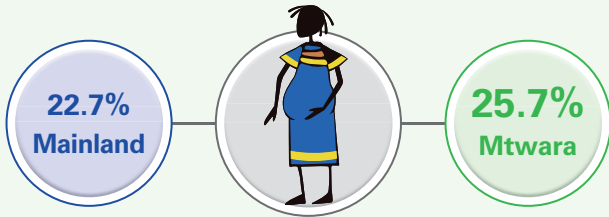


Primary school – Pupil teacher ratio^{10,11}

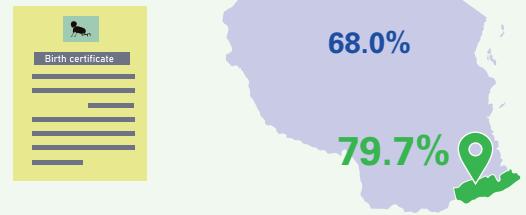

Children with birth certificate (0-4 years)¹²



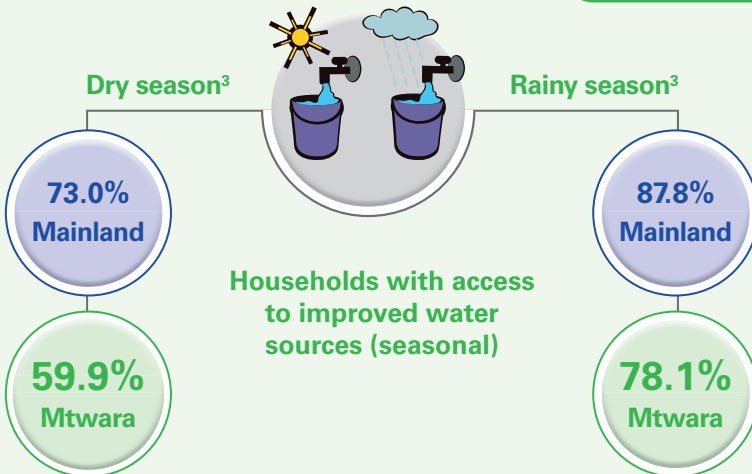
Women age 15-49 years experienced physical violence since the age of 15⁵



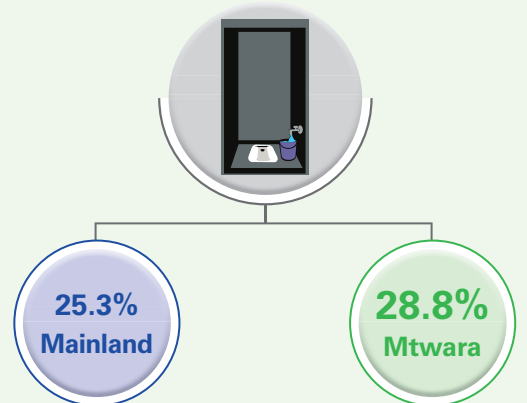
Women age 15-49 years ever experienced sexual violence⁵



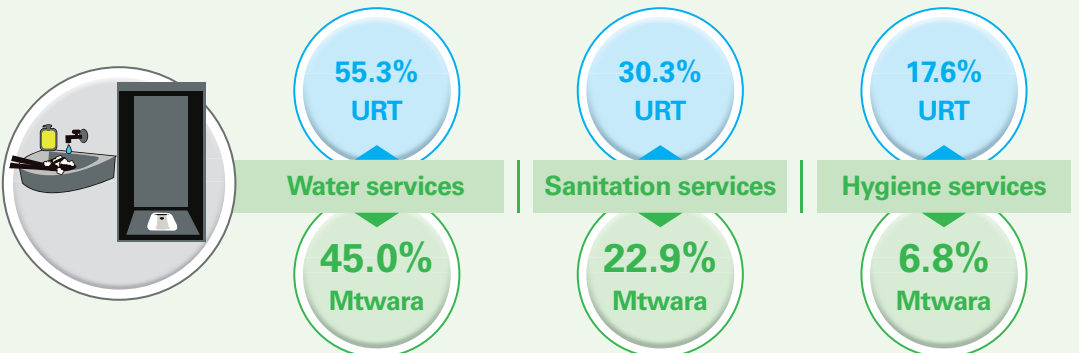
