

**REQUEST FOR EXPRESSION OF INTEREST (EOI) FROM
CIVIL SOCIETY ORGANIZATIONS (CSOs)
FOR THE IMPLEMENTATION OF
SPORT FOR DEVELOPMENT
INTERVENTIONS OF POLICE OFFICERS
EOI NO. UKR/CP/EOI/2018/2 DATED: 17.04.18**

Over the past years, UNICEF-Ukraine has been developing a Sport for Development (S4D) programme for youth to advance social cohesion. Sport remains unparalleled in its ability to attract children, and there is evidence that sport enhance learning and encourage better academic performance, as well as promotes social inclusion of the most vulnerable children. S4D is the intentional use of the universal appeal of sport to achieve a development outcome and encourage positive values and life skills including teamwork, discipline, fairness and respect for others, which in turn shape the behaviour and help to pursue the goals and respond appropriately to events throughout the life.

UNICEF is currently implementing a project “Enhancing Police’s capacities to provide child-friendly responses for children in contact with the law”, that has a component on S4D, aimed at building trustworthy relations between children and the law enforcement bodies.

With this call for expression of interest, UNICEF invites national and international CSOs to submit an expression of interest for participation in potential projects on S4D engaging Police and other law enforcement bodies with vulnerable children and youth. One of the objectives of the S4D intervention by Police with young people is neighbourhood crime prevention. The project, among others, should focus on interventions to develop entry points for Patrol Police officers and Neighbourhood Police inspectors to engage with children through street sport, building trust and social networks. The project might include the following activities:

1. Engaging of Patrol Police officers and Neighbourhood Police inspectors in Sport for Youth activity

The methodology for trainings for police officers needs to be developed and relevant trainings are to be conducted. It is proposed to engage a small number of motivated police officers in three to five pilot cities. Selection of officers to participate in the S4D activities will be made at the stage of training evaluation. Identified police officers will participate in a training on S4D components, building their understanding about S4D approaches, as well as giving skills on how to communicate with youth. Police officers may form football and/or basketball teams, using community fields.

2. Developing cooperation with schools and conducting competitions

It is anticipated that the participating police officers will work with a handful of schools in their city with a goal to engage student football teams with a street football/basketball competition. Small sport championships may be used as a tool to establish positive relationship between children and new, young and motivated police officers. Prizes may be awarded to winners. As the level of interaction increases, the police officers could explore opportunities to train interested young people on S4D to conduct joint outreach with other young people. At the same time, these involved young people could partner with the police officers to develop information outreach on neighbourhood crime prevention and related projects/activities.

The following indicators are proposed to measure the achievements of the project:

- Existence of S4D training for patrol police officers
- Number of police officers participated in training
- Number of sport events
- Number of children and young people participated in sport events
- Number of children and young people participated in information outreach on crime prevention

Geographical scope with priority given to:

1. Kyiv oblast
2. Kharkiv oblast
3. Lviv oblast
4. Odesa oblast
5. Donetsk oblast (GCA)

Duration: up to 12 months.

Application process:

In this regard, expressions of interests (EOI) are solicited from national and international CSOs having relevant expertise and experience as per the above referred to scope of work on partnership basis.

Interested CSOs are requested to submit:

- I. Signed EOI letter (attached as *Annex-1*);
- II. Completed EOI form (attached as *Annex-2*);
- III. Copy of the registration certificate for respective geographic locations/oblasts and/or brief description of how the project will operate in the target geographic locations.
- IV. Copy of latest organizational audit report.

Please note that this is not a request for proposals. Only CSOs with experience in similar assignments and with relevant experienced staff, and providing the above requested information would be considered for pre-qualification and may be subsequently invited for proposals. UNICEF is under no obligation to invite any CSO that has responded to this Expression of Interest to participate in the submission of proposal. UNICEF reserves the right to accept or reject any or all EOI without assigning the reason.
