


Structure of State Budget Allocations



Key Highlights of State Budget Allocations for 2024





SOCIAL PROTECTION AND SOCIAL SUPPORT

Total allocation

(State budget with transfers) From State budget Transfers to local budgets

UAH 487.2 billion

UAH 10.4 billion

▲ UAH 15.7 billion (+3.3%) to 2023 UAH 476.8 billion

KEY EXPENDITURES

Social protection of citizens in difficult life circumstances:

UAH 88.7 billion (+UAH 2.6 billion or +3% to 2023)

Social protection of children and families: UAH 27.6 billion (+3% to 2023) for more than 1.6 million recipients

Social protection of persons with disabilities and children with disabilities: UAH 6.7 billion (+88% to 2023).

Support for low-income families: UAH 20.2 billion (+30% to 2023) for more than 250,000 families. In 2024, transfer values for assistance to low-income families will be increased by 10% (for able-bodied persons from 45% to 55%, for children from 130% to 140%).

Housing subsidies and benefits to citizens: UAH 49.9 billion (+32% to 2023) for 3.2 million households. From 2024, these subsidies will be paid from the Pension Fund of Ukraine

New budget program for the "Development of the system of social services":

Rehabilitation and recreation of children who need special attention and support: UAH 0.3 billion (+6.7% to 2023).

Deinstitutionalization and ensuring the education of children in family or close to family settings (transfer to local budgets): UAH 575.3 million. This constitutes a 57-fold increase to 2023, although it represents only 74% of the 2021 budget allocation.



EDUCATION

KEY EXPENDITURES

Teachers' salaries: UAH 103.2 billion (+UAH 15.6 billion or +17.9% to 2023).

Shelters and safe conditions for students and teachers: UAH 2.5 billion (+UAH 1.0 billion or +66.7% to 2023).

The "New Ukrainian School" program: UAH 1.5 billion (not funded in 2022 and 2023). Education for persons with special educational needs: UAH 0.3 billion (as in 2023).

Equipment for the creation of educational and practical centers of modern professional and technical education: UAH 0.5 billion (not funded in 2022 and 2023).

Restoration and modernization of food blocks in schools: UAH 1.5 billion

Restoration of the school bus park: UAH 1.0 billion (as in 2023).

ECONOMIC ACTIVITY

KEY EXPENDITURES

Preparation and participation of national teams in more than 3,700 sports events and their awards: UAH 4.9 billion.

Preparation and participation of Ukrainian athletes in the Olympic

Implementation of the social project "Active parks — locations of healthy Ukraine": UAH 124.2 million. This project is aimed at supporting mental health and healthy lifestyles for over 5 million Ukrainians.



DEFENSE AND SECURITY

Total allocation: UAH 1672.8 billion, corresponding to 95% of planned State budget revenues for 2024 (UAH 1768.5 billion).

The Fund for the Liquidation of the Consequences of Armed Aggression is not included in the budget for 2024. In previous years, financial resources were allocated to this end (UAH 17.0 billion in 2022; UAH 35.5 billion in 2023).

LOCAL BUDGETS

Transfers to local budgets ▲ UAH 4.5 billion (+2.4%) planned in 2023

For the year 2024:

- The revenues from the taxation of financial support to military personnel will be entirely directed to the State budget. In 2022 and 2023, 64% of these revenues were credited to territorial communities' budgets and 15% to regional budgets instead.
- 64% of the personal income tax of the other taxpayers will be directed to local budgets, as in 2022 and 2023.
- The State Fund for Regional Development is not included in the budget for 2024. In 2023, planned resources (UAH 2.0 billion) were reallocated to finance the defense and security sector.
